

Northern New York Audubon Cullman Grant Guidelines 2016-2017

ALL Applications must be received by March 31, 2016

Audubon's mission is to conserve and restore natural ecosystems, focusing on birds, other wildlife, and their habitats, for the benefit of humanity and the earth's biological diversity. Projects that support these conservation ideals, either through research or education, are eligible for this grant. Projects submitted should be occurring in the Adirondack, Champlain or St. Lawrence region of Northern New York or be beneficial to species that occur in that region. Eligibility includes, but is not limited to, environmental organizations, teachers, graduate students, and research project managers.

Terms

- Project monies will be available for distribution after May 1, 2016.
- Maximum amount of any grant is \$2,500.
- Projects funded must be completed no later than August 31, 2016.
- A project progress report will be due on September 31, 2016.
- A project completion report will be due at the end of the project.
- Funds may be used for salaries, stipends, materials, and expenses that support the specific project for which funding is requested. Overhead expenses cannot be covered by funds from this grant.

Guidelines

- Complete and return the application form on next page.
- Attach your written proposal narrative (limited to two pages) and include the following:
 - o Title of Project
 - o Description of the project for which funds are requested
 - o Time line of project activities
 - o Description of numbers and role of staff or volunteers involved
 - o Anticipated benefits(s) of the project, and how its success will be assessed
 - o Detailed budget specifying expenses for which funds are requested and an assessment of how your project would be affected if you receive less than the requested amount.
